In 2014, The City of Encinitas purchased an abandoned elementary school on 2.8 acres of ocean-view property in downtown Encinitas. In 2016, the City selected the Encinitas Arts, Culture & Ecology Alliance (EACEA) as its partner to transform the abandoned buildings into a center of education, for arts, culture, and ecology.

Site operated as Pacific View Elementary School

Site abandoned by school district due to declining enrollment
- 2014**
Site purchased by City of Encinitas
- 2016**
City selects EACEA as operating partner for transformation to PVAA
- 2016 – Present**
Ongoing site restoration and rehabilitation by EACEA of PVAA

Projected start of PVAA operations and programming

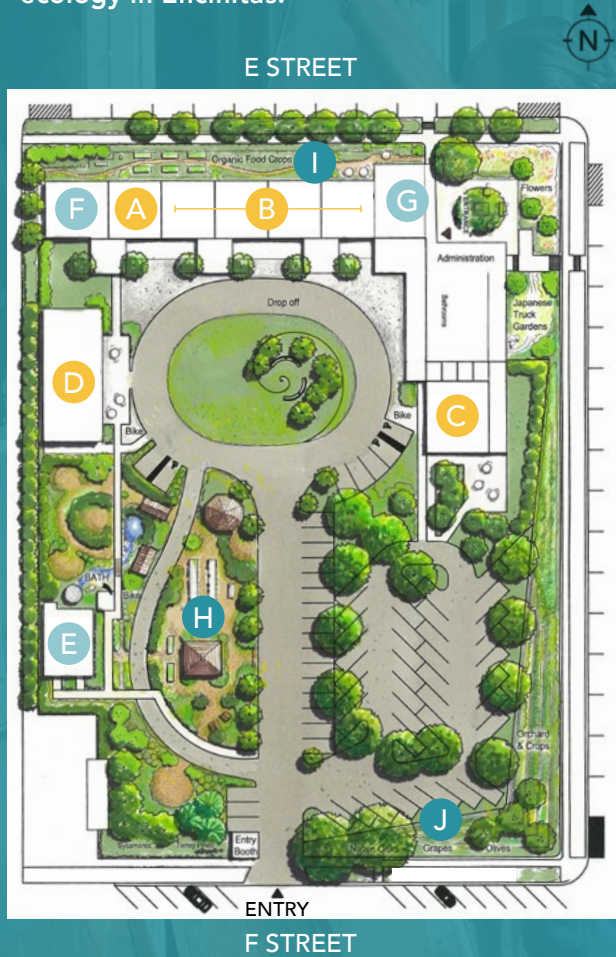
